Sanchai hunuhuncha. I am all right out here at Nepal.

Corona Cases was increasing but nowadays the number of COVID is in decreasing order. Hope you are fine out there .Sorry for the late reply .We had a festival called Tihar in Nepal and before I was busy in making awareness videos regarding COVID for general public. After our festival, We were busy in conducting workshop that was stopped by COVID. Before a week, we are nowadays running a workshop and for 1 months we are occupied by the workshop which was previously stopped by COVID.

Nepal Government has banned the gathering of people due to COVID so we could not run the workshop in site but somehow we conduct online workshop too.

From our simulation center, we are very happy to inform you that we have trained 175 critical care nurses and 100 doctors from COVID-19 dedicated hospital in coordination with Ministry of Health. It's possible all about support from ANMF-US to form simulation center and sustainability of it. That time was very critical time to get foundation sustain, just without any workshop and training we just need to pay the rent and other expenses but however we tried to managed. In Nepal last 4 months was very challenging for all.

We received a grants for sustainability of SimMed Center for a one year and got finished. We would thank Anmf and especially you for supporting us .

And from your support, in last year without conducting any workshop in last four months we have trained around 550 nurses and 150 medical doctors especially medical officer and anesthesiologist. These trained doctor and nurses will help for the better care of critical ill patients in ICU.

Now forwards we are conducting the workshop and training and hope all thing in Nepal will be better. Really Sorry for the late response.
