3. **NCCDF training Program:** NCCDF had conducted a training program of “PPE use and Hand hygiene” and “Infection prevention and control training for doctors and Nurses of APF and Teku Hospital” which was funded by ANMF-Nepal
4. **Swab transportation Vehicle:** The swab collection vehicle made great progress. Swab transportation vehicle operated for 30 days collecting an average of 20 swabs per day. The vehicle came to a great use of the National Public Laboratory in Teku and Epidemiology and disease control division (EDCD). The vehicle collected samples, delivered RDT tests and different medical equipments. The Teku lab and EDCD has really appreciated ANMF for its help in this crucial time.
5. **Tele-consultation TUTH teaching Hospital:** ANMF-Nepal also provided TUTH Teaching Hospital with a full set of computer and a mobile set to start a tele-consultation center which helps patients to connect with doctors online. Many applications like Facebook, Zoom, Viber are used to connect with the patients.
6. **National Innovation center (NIC):** ANMF-Nepal also wanted to support the innovative ideas which were preventing the spread of Corona Virus. NIC were providing sample collection booth which is a great help for sample collection and also for limited use of the PPE set in this crisis. So, ANMF-Nepal donated Rs. 10, 00,000 to NIC to support this innovative idea and also encourage them. NIC have been involved in various projects like Sample collection booth, UV radiation disinfection chamber, Intubation hoods and Robots. They have already handed over the sample booth to TUTH teaching Hospital, Bir Hospital, Teku Hospital, Army Hospital, APF Hospital and KMC. ANMF-Nepal has decided to provide an additional of Rs.2,00,000 to NIC. NIC has added 3D made swab sticks in addition to all its project.

7. **Health Foundation Nepal (HFN):** ANMF-Nepal also supported HFN with the amount of Rs.2,00,000 for the N95 decontamination UGVI chamber. HFN will provide the N95 decon UGVI chambers to selected public hospitals to help them prevent the spread of Corona Virus.
8. **National Medical Association (NMA) training facilities:** ANMF-Nepal provided NMA with the necessary equipments for the training facilities. ANMF will set up the training facilities in order to conduct the online training programs by NMA. The training facilities will be used for different training and educational programs.
9. **Powered air-purifying respirator (PAPR):** ANMF-Nepal has bought 12 PAPR which ANMF will handover to different major institution dealing with Covid-19 patients.
10. **Monitoring and Management of children and pregnant/postpartum mothers at risk of Covid-19 in Nepal:** ANMF-Nepal has decided to fund this project initiated by Dr.Sangita Basnet. This project will try to decrease the morbidity and mortality due to the direct and indirect effect of Covid-19 in the children and mothers in Isolation and quarantine facilities.
