

COVID-19 Isolation Center Plan

Location: Birgunj, Parsa District, Province 2

Proposed by: Sano Paila

1. **Purpose:**

To support the national-led response to the coronavirus.

- With cases of COVID-19 increasing in Parsa and especially Birgunj, a large number of quarantine centres are required to tackle the coronavirus crisis, and existing facilities are already overburdened.
- There is a dire need to establish isolation centres for vulnerable patients with COVID symptoms.

2. **Objectives:**

To set-up a 40-bed isolation centre in coordination with local authorities in Birgunj, Parsa

- Play a role in relieving pressure on the existing hospital systems
- Support authorities to build an isolation centre to take care of moderate COVID-19 patients, including vulnerable patients and elderly

3. **Description:**

Set up a 40-bed isolation centre and arrange adequate facilities based on that issued national guidelines of the federal government:

- Provide 40 beds, along with bedding materials, hygiene and sanitary kits, towels, masks, and other daily items.
- Provide a medical team: 1 doctor (Facility Incharge), 3 Nurses, 2 HA/CMAs and arrange provision for visiting doctors from government hospital
- Set-up drinking water facility, including provision for hot water
- Provide cutleries (plates/glasses), along with 4 meals per day
- Provide security, cleaning services and set-up other needed items

4. **Budget:**

Total Budget for 3 months: **NPR 6,804,989 / USD 56,708**

- Goal A - Nutritional Program: NPR 1,554,210 / USD 12,951
- Goal B - Hygiene/Utility Kits: NPR 475,575 / USD 3,963.13
- Goal C- Facility/Utilities: 2,241,000 / USD 18,675
- Goal D - Human Resources (Medical team/security): NPR 1,000,000 / USD \$8,333.33
- Goal E - PPE and Disinfection: NPR 1,336,000 / USD \$11,133.33
- Contingency Costs: NPR 198,203.55 / USD \$1,651.70

5. **Timeline:** 3 months
