



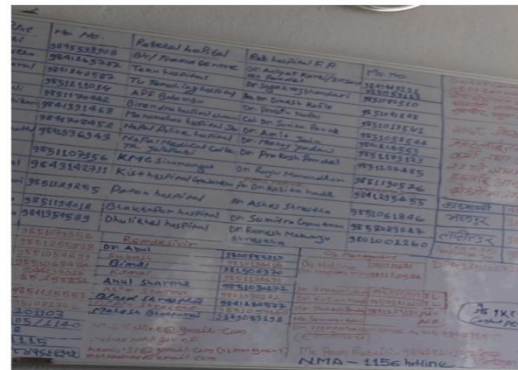

Communication center at Health Emergency operation center (HEOC)

As the second wave of Corona Virus hit Nepal, Cases were on a rise and people were finding difficult to arrange general beds, oxygenated beds, ICU beds and ventilator beds. This call center was able to function in coordination with America Nepal Medical Foundation, Ministry of Health and Population (MoHP) and Health Emergency operation center (HEOC) which helped arrange over 165 oxygen beds, 40 ICU beds, 3 HDU and 13 General beds. Also, 239 calls for general consultation have been received by this communication center for Covid patients in Kathmandu and also major cities of Nepal. The call center is open to general public with the Hotline number 1133, 1115 and also the mobile number +977-9851255837, +977-9851255839. People can easily dial these numbers and get connected to the call center. The communication center also facilitates various calls about medical consultation for corona virus which was about 20 calls per hour at its peak time. People also called about general inquire for the vaccination as well. We have three doctors Dr. Nirdesh Pokhrel, Dr. Sumit Yadav and Dr. Ranjan Thapa who are on around the clock duty which is for 24 hours.
